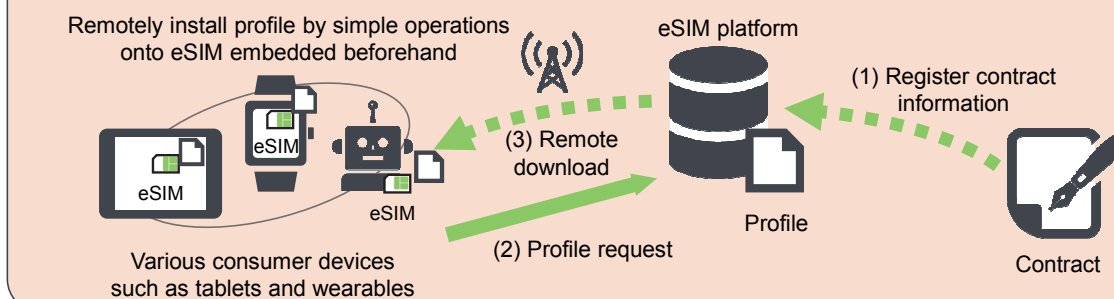
(a) Conventional UIM
