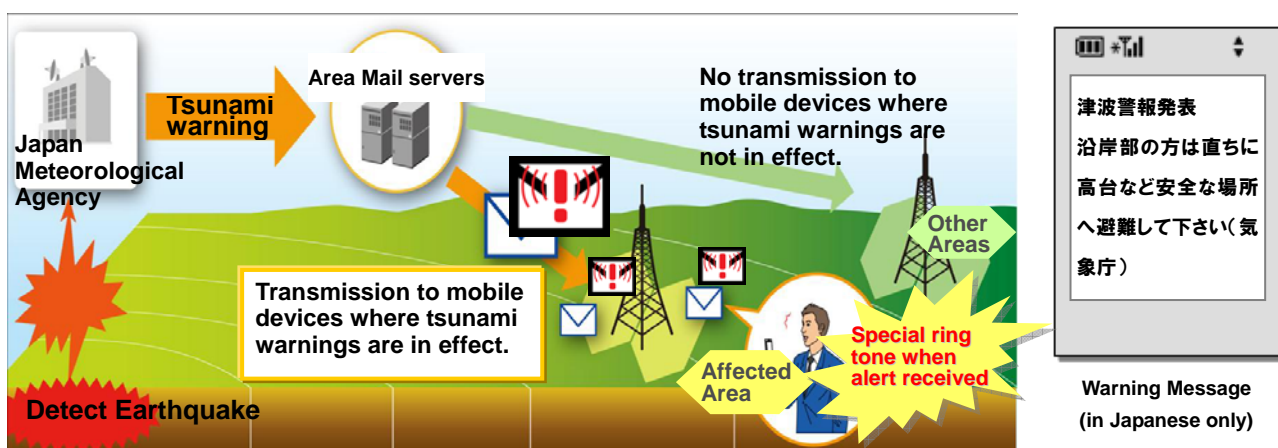

Overview of Newly Expanded Early Warning “Area Mail™” Service

From February 24, DOCOMO’s Early Warning “Area Mail” service will begin transmitting tsunami warnings (in Japanese only) issued by the Japan Meteorological Agency to DOCOMO mobile devices in afflicted areas. The warnings cover all potentially hazardous tsunami, including “major tsunami” expected to reach or exceed three meters and “tsunami” expected to reach up to around two meters. Tsunami advisories are not covered.



Compatible Handsets

All DOCOMO mobile devices compatible with Early Warning “Area Mail” can receive earthquake early warnings and tsunami warnings. Most but not all devices can also receive disaster and evacuation information. The message-reception settings of 905i, 906i, 705i, and 706i series devices must be configured manually to use the service.

Fee and Registration

Early Warning “Area Mail” is completely free, so users do not pay a monthly fee or communication charges to receive warnings and information. Also, registration is not required to receive the service.
